

Summer School Recruitment – Key Information:

1. **Eligibility:** The "VINCI RELOADED – Interdisciplinary International Silesian Summer School" is open to international students who have completed at least one year of undergraduate (Bachelor's) studies or are currently enrolled in graduate (Master's) studies. Eligible disciplines include Computer Science, Chemical Sciences, Physical Sciences, Materials Engineering, or related fields.
2. **Timeline:** Recruitment runs from the announcement date until **March 8, 2026**. Please note that this deadline is subject to change; any updates will be posted on the Project Website.
3. **Capacity:** There are **25 places** available, distributed as follows: 5 for Physical Sciences, 5 for Chemical Sciences, 5 for Computer Science, 5 for Materials Engineering, and 5 for Microscopy.
4. **How to Apply:** Candidates must complete and submit the online application form available on the Project Website.
5. **Restrictions:** Applicants may apply for **only one** chosen discipline.
6. **Selection Criteria:**
 - a. **Formal Criterion:** Confirmation of international student status and completion of the required years/level of study in a relevant field. This is verified via a certificate from the candidate's home university.
 - b. **Qualifying Criteria (Pass/Fail):**
 - A Grade Point Average (GPA) above 3.0 (verified by a university certificate in PDF).
 - A written justification for the chosen research topic (submitted via the application form).
 - English proficiency sufficient for active participation (verified by the candidate's declaration in the form).
 - c. **Scoring Criteria (Weighting):**
 - Overall GPA (weight: 0.6).
 - Number of completed semesters – higher progress is preferred (weight: 0.3; verified by university certificate).
 - One recommendation letter from an academic staff member at the home university (weight: 0.1; submitted as a PDF).
